It is now almost 15 years since Peter Young was asked to take his first Antiques History session at The Hayfield School. ... Soon Peter was taking sessions at Hayfield, Worksops' Bassetlaw College in addition to his everyday work. ...

In 1994 the first outing was organised to the Gladstone Pottery in Staffordshire and the success of this set the ball rolling to several other places. So far the day trips have covered: Wedgwood, Ironbridge, Burleigh House, Chatsworth House, Keddlestone Hall, Oakwell Hall, Benningbrough Hall, Warwick Castle, Fairfax House, Carlton Towers, Brodsworth Hall and The Coalport Museum.



In 1997 the first weeklong excursion was to visit the Sevres Museum and the Paris Auction Houses. This proved so successful that the trip was repeated in 2005.

This year it is the Dresden area of Eastern Germany. Some of the students from the Springthorpe classes are going on this trip.
